

# cheerfuldogs Canine Education



## What classes are available for my dog?

We offer two types of “cheerfuldogs Canine Education” classes for all dog owners. As an AVA-accredited trainer, our lessons are consistent with AVA’s guidelines.

**In-Home Sessions:** these are one-on-one lessons conducted at your home and are tailored to address specific behavioural challenges or requirements for you and your dog. Each session lasts one hour and the first session includes consultation and evaluation to determine what training is needed. The fee for each session is S\$100 for 1 dog, or \$180 for 2 dogs.

**Group Classes:** these are conducted at an external venue and all participants go through a basic obedience programme. The programme teaches the basic obedience cues of ***name recognition, focus, touch, sit, down, stay, come, loose-leash walking and heeling***, over the span of 8 sessions (each lasting an hour). Solutions for addressing common behaviour problems will also be discussed during class, and owners need to demonstrate their ability to communicate with their dog in a variety of situations at the end of the course. The fee for the 8-session course is S\$400 per dog/ owner. Depending on venue arrangements, we require a minimum of two to four participants to start the course.

Sometimes, some dogs require more time to learn, or their owners need more practice, so where eligible, they may attend future Group Classes for free, as a refresher.

**Note:** we reserve the right to evaluate each participant in the Group Class. In cases where a dog is reactive (e.g. barking, lunging, growling at other dogs or people) we will discuss alternative training options with the owner.
